## **Explanation** Abbott Diagnostics has received information from Toshiba, the supplier of the ICT Pre-Amp Board, indicating the board's photo couplers may degrade over time. Affected ARCHITECT *c*Systems will generate repeated calibration failures for the ICT analytes (sodium, potassium, and chloride).

**Patient Impact** Falsely elevated patient results may occur only for samples whose recovery is below the low calibrator set points. This is mitigated by calibration that occurs every 24 hours and by controls that are run every 8 hours. There have been no reports of impact to patient results. The overall risk was assessed to be low.

**Necessary** Actions No action is required of you at this time to replace your board. Abbott has identified the systems which may contain the affected boards, and will be making arrangements with you to replace the board at no charge. All replacements are expected to be completed within the next three months.

Follow the instructions in the reagent package inserts for ICT Sample Diluent (List Number 2P32). Ensure that calibration occurs every 24 hours, and controls are run every 8 hours.

If you receive repeated calibration failures for ICT analytes which are not resolved through normal troubleshooting, please contact your local area customer support. Reference this letter so that a service representative can be dispatched to replace the board.
